PETER BAIME

Peter Baime is a professional flamenco guitarist and a faculty member at Cardinal Stritch University, UWM and the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music. He has studied in Spain with guitarists Diego and Gastor and has been a leading exponent of flamenco guitar in the Midwest. Baime has concertized extensively in the U.S. and Puerto Rico, with additional concerts in Spain, Canada, Italy and Mexico.

Baime has accompanied leading flamenco dancers and singers and has worked regularly in Chicago 1986 performing in concert, stage shows and clubs. Additionally he has appeared in more than 2,500 schools as a performer and numerous Public Television and Radio broadcasts. Peter Baime has five scores to his credit and has transcribed a large repertoire of flamenco pieces that are distributed internationally. His last effort won him an Emmy Award from the National Academy of Television and Sciences for his original musical score in a PBS Television documentary in the fa II of 2000.
