Milwaukee, WI – The MacDowell Club of Milwaukee culminates its centennial season with a celebratory concert on Sunday evening, the 23rd of May. It will be presented in the Nancy Kendall Theater housed in the northern wing of the Joan Steele Stein Center for Communication / Fine Arts at Cardinal Stritch University, 6801 North Yates Road, Fox Point. The Stein Center is located on the northern-most road of the Stritch campus, easily accessible from Port Washington Road south of the Green Tree exit off of I-43 or via North Yates Road, just beyond Santa Monica Boulevard. There is ample free parking in Lots 5 and 8, both immediately adjacent to the building.

Enid Bootzin Berkovits, the Club's creative Programs Chair and President-Elect, is maintaining a sense of mystery about the program promising a delightful evening of musical surprises. The performance is open and free to the public although donations are always most welcome.
