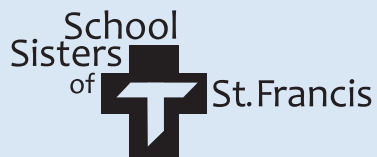

**Shanti Daya** has won worldwide acclaim for the conviction, elegance and clarity of her piano performance. She received her Licentiate in Piano Performance from the Royal Schools of Music, London, and her Bachelor and Master degrees in piano performance from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Ms. Daya has appeared as soloist with the UW-Madison Symphony Orchestra, Concord Chamber Orchestra, Waukesha Symphony, Kettle Moraine Symphony, and the Malaysian National Symphony. She has performed solo recitals and chamber music concerts for the U.S.I.S., the Embassy of the U.S.A., the British Council, and the Embassy of Norway, and appeared on Television Malaysia/Singapore and on National Public Radio in Wisconsin. Ms. Daya serves on the music faculty at Carroll University in Waukesha and maintains a private piano studio in Brookfield, Wisconsin, where she resides.
